

## ANNUAL REPORT 2023-2024

NES Education college; Jabalpur, established in the year 2005 is managed by New Education Society; Napier Town, Jabalpur. The college started with B. Ed, program (intake of hundred students). The department of language and humanities (B.A Program) was established in the year 2016. Presently the college offers B.A & B.Ed. programmes. The college has in its vision a model for higher education which empowers individuals to realise their dreams along with the needs of society and helping in the development of nation and the world at large.

To impart quality education, the college has been involved in various innovations in curricular and teaching aspects. Since its inception the college aims at holistic development of students fostering in them academic excellence, social concern, character formation, shaping them to become fruitful individuals of the society. Keeping in line with its motto, "vidya dhanam sarv pradhanam" the college is determined to provide quality education to the learners.

In academics the pass percentage of B. Ed. Final year students is 92%. Total number of students appeared is 83 and the students who have passed is 76. All the students passed with first divisions and five out of these scored 80% and above. The topper of the course is Nikita Shukla with 84.78%, Second topper is Palak Agarwal with 84.13% and third position is bagged by Shefali Sainy with 81.38%. The result of B.A. 2024 pass out batch is 86%. Total number of students appeared is 51 and the students who have passed is 44. Number of students passed with first divisions is 34 and rest of the students passed with second division. Afiya Ansari is the topper of the course with 7.88 CGPA. Second topper is Kavita Sahu with 7.88 CGPA and third position is bagged by Smridhi Patel with 7.81 CGPA.

The college has a well-developed and functional Electoral Literacy Club (ELC) with an objective to promote the electoral literacy among students and the society. Mr. Ganeshan Swami, a faculty from the college has been nominated as the Nodal Officer of the ELC. Campus Ambassador of the club is Gaurav Dehriya and Karyakarini Adhyaksha is Chanchal Jha. ELC conducted many activities during the session. On 9 August 2023 Shapath Grahana Ceremony was organised under SVEEP (Systematic Voters Education and Electoral Participation Program). The aim is to encourage all the eligible voters to vote with awareness. In this regard the procedure for online application to get the voter ID Card was taught to students and online application form was submitted. On 19 October 2023 the members of the college ELC Club participated in the district level Nukkad Natak competition, organized by District election officer, Voters awareness committee, Collector office, Jabalpur. Further from 9 March 2024 to 12 March 2024 various activities as Debate competition, voters awareness rally, Seminar and a Nukkad natak were organized under SVEEP With the aim to create awareness towards voters rights.

The college is always striving towards providing holistic education to students enabling them to be the fruitful members of the family, society, the nation and the world at large. In line to this various activities have been organized to inculcate social ethics, values and life skills among the students. In this regard following activities have been organized during the session:

- The college has started the publication of a half yearly news letter, EDU EXPRESS, to provide the details of achievement and activities of faculty and students of the college.

- A large scale plant distribution program was organized on 10 July 2024, the last working day of B.Ed. forth semester students to create awareness towards environment and spreading the message to society through students as ambassadors.
- On 15 August 2023 Independence day was celebrated in the college with great joy and fervour.
- Khel Mahotsav was celebrated on 29 August 2023 to commemorate the birth anniversary of legendry hockey player Major Dhyan Chand .
- Teacher's day was celebrated on 5 September to commemorate the birth anniversary of Dr. S. Radhakrishnan.
- Orientation Programme for newly admitted students was held on 15 September 2023. The aim is to make the students familiar about the college, its functioning and the program for which they are enrolled.
- Welcome party for fresher's and Farewell party for pass out students was organized on 30 October 2023.
- Republic Day was celebrated on 26 January 2024 to commemorate the Republic Day.
